# TEACH 2021-2022

**Annual Impact Report** 

### ABORTION PROVIDERS ARE REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM CHAMPIONS.

- In anticipation of the fall of Roe, TEACH leadership worked closely with CA Asm. Cottie Petrie-Norris and the Future of Abortion Council to sponsor AB 1918, the California Reproductive Health Service Corps, and advance our bill through the House and Senate.
- AB 1918 was signed into law by Gov. Gavin Newsom on September 27th, 2022, creating the first of its kind state funded abortion workforce development and training program in California.



#### ABORTION PROVIDERS PROTECT COMMUNITIES AND KEEP FAMILIES HEALTHY.

- 2,391 abortions provided by our residents at local clinics
- 69 residents trained in comprehensive abortion care, including options counseling and provision of aspiration and medication abortion.





#### NO DISTANCE IS TOO FAR TO TRAVEL FOR RESIDENTS TO PROVIDE SKILLED AND COMPASSIONATE ABORTION CARE.

- 8 residents completed external rotations at clinics across the US
- 3 residents received \$2,000 FutureGen External Rotation Funds to train in Mexico City and Kansas/Oklahoma



#### ABORTION STORYTELLER'S SMASH STIGMA ONE STORY AT A TIME.

- Our 6rd annual storytelling event, "Beyond the A Word" brought together over 250 community members to break the stigma and silence of abortion, celebrate abortion providers and support TEACH
- 650 listens of our podcast "Beyond the A Word"

- 50 2ND year residents trained in comprehensive reproductive healthcare
- 19 advanced CREATE residents trained and mentored in abortion care, leadership, reproductive justice and advocacy

- New and revised 7th Edition of the TEACH Abortion Training Curriculum launched

- 174 course completions of online medication abortion course by primary care providers in 5 countries
